IMPORTANT REMINDERS

This worksheet demonstrates an example of the courses taken at Wayland by grade. Students may deviate from this sequence, but the proposed change must meet the satisfaction of the Academic Office and be approved by the DCII.

Students must complete a minimum of 20 credits of core courses and 2 credits in Fine Arts (either music or visual).

All students are required to carry a minimum of 5 core courses each semester.

How to Use this Guide

This box is checked once all **required** credits in that subject have been earned.

This number represents an example of the grade level at which many Wayland students take the course. This may differ for each student.
